MINUTES

MINUTES:

The minutes of August 16, 2022 were approved.

PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEWS

The Committee reviewed the following permit applications:

- Neil and Barbara McQuid, Weare, NH, Map 107, Lot 50. Shoreland Permit #2022-02286.
 - The Committee strongly discouraged any new construction within the 50' waterfront buffer.
 - The Committee recognizes that the new structure and plan will be an improvement in stormwater management, however:
 - The Committee questioned if there is a stormwater management system for the deck, given it is considered impervious and within the 50' waterfront buffer.
 - The Committee commented that the stormwater management system must be monitored and maintained.
- Alteration of Terrain – File Number: 20220906-161, Owner: Eversource Energy, Dated 9/6/2022.
 - The Committee reviewed the AOT permit application for Eversource Energy's application for P106 transmission line optical ground wire (opgw) and structure replacement project in Goffstown prepared by Normandeau Associates Inc.
 - The Committee commented that they request that the applicant seek to ensure that any debris be removed, and the land reforested, and habitat restored in the areas disturbed to status quo ante.
 - The application highlighted the potential for several turtle and snake species of concern in the area, therefore the timing of the project is critical to avoid impact. Additionally, it is recommended that "wildlife friendly" erosion control materials be used.

CORRESPONDENCE/GENERAL DISCUSSION:

Jane commented on the two ARM grant proposals she forward to the Committee

OLD BUSINESS:

- Jane provided the Committee an update on riverbank stabilization along the Piscataquog River on Bass Island. The City of Manchester will seek to apply for funds to stabilize the shoreline on Bass Island Park. Jane will continue to monitor.

- Factory Street, Goffstown – Alan gave the Committee an update on his observations.
- Gregg's Falls hydroelectric dam drawdown - The Committee discussed observations on the Glen Lake drawdown.
- The Committee will continue to review the existing By Laws and the new By Laws template. If changes are recommended the Committee will seek a vote.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Committee congratulates the former Committee Chair, Dick Ludders, for receiving the 2022 Raymond E. Closson award from Southern New Hampshire Planning Commission.
