PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEWS

- [AOT-2194, 2022-01558 Shoreland Permit, Eversource Gregg Substation, Goffstown.](#)

The Committee reviewed the updated Shoreland Permit for upgrades to the Gregg Substation in Goffstown by Eversource. Nick Golon provided the Committee an overview and answered questions.

PRLAC Comments:

- The Committee supports the update to the shoreland permit given:
 - We understand that there is no change in impervious surface area because one type of impervious surface (gravel) is being replaced with another type (concrete).
 - We understand that the existing low area will be dredged and plants including knotweed will be removed, and that this low area will function as stormwater management.
 - We understand that the seed mix to be used is that recommended by NH Fish and Game Department.
 - We are concerned with contaminants potentially being deposited in the stormwater area in the long-term and would like to know if there is anything in the permitting that can address this.
 - Is there in the rules the potential for mitigation given that some of the impervious pole storage area will be within 100 feet of Glen Lake?
 - Mr. Golon sent the PRLAC the 2022 plans and some updated information early on, but that did not include the shoreland application or updated plans. John Magee failed to notice this till the night of the PRLAC meeting. Mr. Golon is going to send the full application and plans to the PRLAC.
